Comment:

Horsley Parish Council wish to make the following comments regarding this application:

1. The Parish Council strongly supports the observations/comments already submitted by local residents.
2. The whole of the land of Horsley Hall (including the field where the proposed building would be built) is in the Horsley Conservation Area.
3. The building of a building such as a storage barn in a Conservation Area would set a precedent for further development. This would have a devastating effect of the landscape.
4. No trees should be felled within the Conservation Area, as to do so would change the landscape forever.
5. There would be a highways issue due to the lack of adequate infrastructure to allow vehicular access to the location.
6. Horsley Hall is a private residence with no farming activity taking place.
7. Noise pollution is also of great concern.
